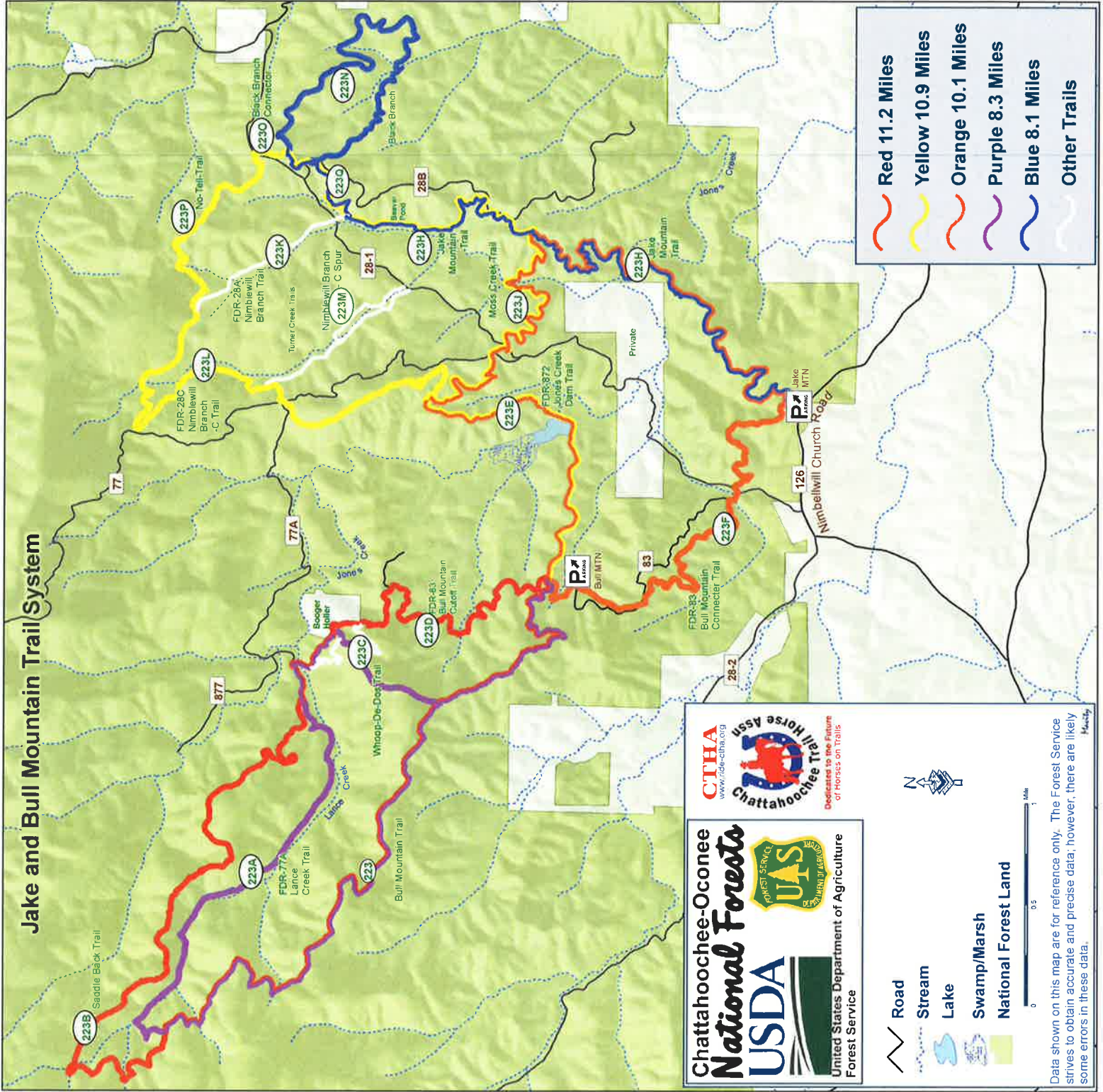


Jake and Bull Mountain Trail System
